The aim of the course is to provide hands-on experience and up-date the knowledge and skills of Seed Analysts, Seed Testing Officers, Seed Technologists and Seed Quality Regulation Personnel of various Agencies and to strengthen cooperation, uniformity and information exchange in the field of Seed Quality Control and Seed Testing at National level. It is intended for persons working on seed production, seed quality control and Seed testing in government organizations / public and private seed sectors.

It is designed to provide participants with the knowledge and skills for effective seed production and assessment of seed quality aspects, understand better seed quality assessment system, and improve the present system to meet international standards. Considering the above participants should be actual technicians/analysts/technologists with at least a basic knowledge or experience in seed production and quality regulation and testing

Organizations may depute/nominate their officers/officials to register for the participation in the training programme. Interested Officers/ Officials should register after duly filling the attached Registration Form with short curriculum vitae about their working experiences and technical duties which they perform in their laboratory/ working places. The duly filled Registration forms may be by post.
